Gwich'in Territorial Park Hiking Trails

Inukshuk created a trail planning and construction framework to guide trail development in Gwich'in Territorial Park. The project involved consideration of existing site, trail routing to avoid falcon nest disturbance, visitor market analysis and recreation trends as well as capital costs for various trail segments. Suggestions for interpretive signage and way finding, a Gwich'in Territorial Park plant report and a trail maintenance manual were also provided. Trail construction was started in 2013.
